Summer program for students offered

Hawaii Learning Resource, in partnership with Assets School, announces a Summer Spy Academy Camp for students entering second through fifth grades.

The camp, to be held at the Hawaii Preparatory Academy village campus, will provide students with hands-on learning experience designed to inspire joy in learning and an opportunity to significantly improve learning and social skills. Participants will also benefit from a better understanding of their own strengths and interests. The spy theme will provide an emphasis on observation, focus and listening. The primary goal is to help students develop a stronger interest in learning, more learning skills and also take away specific strategies to make learning easier and more fun.

Hawaii Learning Resource is the flagship program of North Hawaii Women and Children's Service, a Waimea-based non-profit organization established in 1997. Its mission is to help and empower diverse learners in school and in life.

Target students for the camp will be struggling and gifted students entering second through fifth grade in 2010-11 who are underachieving or demonstrate a need for improvement in reading, writing and math skills. The camp will be held in two sessions each for 20 students with the first session June 14 to 25 and the second session June 28 to July 9. The camps will run from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday.
